COUNCIL BUDGET: GREENS HELP SAVE FRONTLINE SERVICES

Green wins also mean better funding for street cleaning and recycling

As you may know, Bromborough library closed last October due to cuts imposed by Labour and Conservative councillors in last year's budget. This year, all political parties, except the Conservatives, voted to save libraries, leisure centres, youth services and play schemes at budget committee.

Councillor Jo Bird says, "Greens had five clear priorities for the budget: **protect valued frontline services, improve provision for the most vulnerable, cut pollution, reduce pay inequalities and no compulsory redundancies.** Not only did the budget meet all our priorities but we also secured a better outcome for vital environmental services including recycling and street cleaning. I'm proud that the nine-strong Green group played such a positive and constructive role in agreeing this year's budget."
